

In a nutshell

People were attracted to Jesus for he had a message that resonated in their hearts.

When he had finished speaking, Jesus told Simon to put out into deep water for a catch. They had caught nothing all night, but when they obeyed Jesus' word, their catch was abundant and they recognised him as Lord.

They left everything to follow Jesus and share in his work of drawing people to God.

" Put out into deep water and pay out your nets for a catch."

The first book published by Pope Francis after his election was entitled *The Name of God is* Mercy. It was the outcome of an extensive interview between the new Pope and a distinguished Italian journalist. In it Pope Francis explains that "God's logic is a logic of love". It is a theme that is dear to Pope Francis and one he has often returned to throughout his pontificate. On one occasion, for example, he spoke of Jesus as "the human face of *God's mercy*", because in all that he does and says, Jesus reflects God's logic of love. He is ready to accept people where they are and as they are, without waiting for them to become perfect. When they are conscious of their unworthiness, then they are ready for God's service.

It's easy for us to be disheartened by our apparent inability to live up to our baptismal calling. But it's tragic when we allow that to happen. As today's readings show, God is not put off because of our inadequacies and weaknesses; in God's eyes no one is beyond God's mercy, no matter how often or how badly they may have failed. Nothing can take away God's love for us and often it is when we become conscious of our sinfulness that the Lord is ready to draw us closer to himself. This is not, of course, the way the world sees things; but this is the logic of divine love. And once we are convinced that our God is a God whose name is mercy then our failings, far from casting us down, will have the opposite effect: they will draw us closer to God: they will inspire us to become the kind of friends that the Lord wants us to be.
