Jesus' question is an invitation for us to answer for ourselves. "Who do you say I am?" Who is Jesus for us? Is he simply a name or a person from History? in a nutshell

Jesus praying impressed his disciples. When Jesus asked them who they thought he was, Peter said: 'the Christ of God'.

Jesus then tells them that he will suffer, die and be raised to life. Furthermore, those who want to follow him will experience renunciation and suffering as they bear the burdens of each day for his sake.

Paradoxically, in doing so, they will find life.

- Response to the psalm:** My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God.

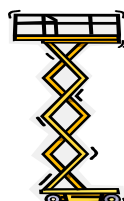
