## In a nutshell

The ten lepers are outcasts from their community, and in their pain and isolation they call out to Jesus as He passes by.

We might not be lepers, but burdened by our failings and inadequacies, we can feel isolated from those around us.

Sometimes a person we love and trust can help us to call out to Jesus in faith, and find healing through gratitude for our many blessings.

Those among the followers of Jesus who had heard his parable of the good Samaritan might not have been surprised at what happens in today's Gospel, in his encounter with the lepers. Jesus is on the road that borders Galilee and Samaria, so there is always the chance of a further comparison between the chosen people and those they regard as outsiders. Yet he is the one who comes back to Jesus and thanks him, praising God for what Jesus has done.

How we welcome outsiders into our midst is a concern of so many countries today. Various elements converge to undermine our freedom to open our arms and accept the outsider as a blessing rather than curse. We are afraid. We are afraid of the unknown, whether it be the unknown of race, colour, language or creed. We fear the world as we have known it will be utterly changed, even if that world has not been a particularly happy or rewarding one. We fear that we will be overwhelmed by the numbers of those who are different from us; that we will lose our jobs and our homes. We are also disdainful of different ways of life. We have an inbuilt belief that our way of doing things is right, even if, again, it does not fulfil our hopes and dreams, and the cultures of others threatens our cultures and our patterns of life.

We might wonder at times whether his listeners felt the same way about Jesus. He must have made them feel very uncomfortable about their way of living and how limited and enclosed it was. It takes great acts of faith and love on our part to overcome our fears and open our hearts to all who knock at our doors. Perhaps we can only do it through recognising that we have so much to thank God for and, through this celebration of life, we change our perspective, and want to offer it to others we meet, and to be open to the gifts they bring in their turn.




## A message from the Archdiocese of Sydney
