As schools resume we will be able to have small prayer services in the classroom— or even class Masses. We will let you know when this will go ahead. Thang made his profession in Vietnam in 2008 and was ordained in 2016. #### Hints

- 4. To cut a meringue pie neatly but both sides of the knife.

#### Quick Salmon Quiche

Beat together well in a mixing bowl.

3 eggs

1 1/2 cups of milk

Combine 1/2 cup SR flour

1/2 cup melted butter

1 cup grated cheese

1 tin (210/220g) pink salmon 1 cup cooked mixed vegetables/spinach/broccoli

Add egg and mix mixture to missing bowl and mix well.

Pour into flan tin and bake in moderate oven for 30-40 minutes.


