We pray for families - supporting them with the increased stress of confinement. Lord, these are difficult times. Covid-19 has brought many changes to our families. Children who spent their days at school and parents who spend their working lives travelling are now all home.

For some this is a blessing, a time to reconnect. But as the weeks of confinement stretch out ahead of us and the novelty of being home together wears thin, nerves might fray.

Give us the patience, Lord to live together as one. Help us be more tolerant of each other. Help us recognise when someone in our household needs space. Empower us to willingly play our part in keeping our families together. We especially remember and pray for those for whom home may be a place of hurt. O Lord hear our prayer.

We pray for people alone in isolation - Lord, we know that social distancing is the one chance we have to defeat Covid-19, to slow down its spread. But in distancing ourselves from others, many of us are home, alone. Our physical contact with others is limited or non-existent.

For most people, this level of isolation is hard to deal with. We're used to meeting people in the street, in the shop, in our workplace, in our church. Activities we have taken for granted – eating in or our with friends, popping around to a neighbour for a cup of tea and a chat, going to concerts or plays - these have all be suspended. Some of us are still connected to the outside world by phone or internet. We can still see the faces of our friends and families on our phones or computer screens. We can still hear their voices . But for many, their view of the outside world is limited to the empty streets they can see from their windows.

Bless us in our new found isolation. Help us cope, knowing that as part of your family, we are never truly alone.

Ingredients: 50g Butter 1.251r chicken stock Method: Heat oil and Butter, add leeks and fry. Add seasonings, nutmeg and 1 tbl sp Oil Salt, Pepper simmer for 30 mins. Boil potatoes for 30 mins also. Cool and Blend

4 Leeks, sliced Pinch of Nutmeg until smooth. Add Cream and heat through (do not boil) Adjust

4 Potatoes, sliced 3/4 cups Cream seasoning, garnish with chives and enjoy


