## Some Directives for Churches and Liturgies in the Archdiocese of Sydney

Churches are open, but no more than 50 people may attend at once. Churches closed outside of services.

- This applies to private prayer, confessions, mass baptisms funerals, Eucharistic adoration, the divine offices, rosary in common, bible study etc.
- Only 20 attendees are permitted at Weddings
- Contact details of all those entering the church (name and phone number) must be recorded
- Spatial distancing (at least 1.5m from each other, the 4 square-meter rule) and hygiene directions (including regularly disinfecting the church) must be observed: attendees may sit only in marked place places, to queue at a distance from others, to take care when coughing or sneezing and to avail themselves of hand sanitizer provided.
- Holy Communion shall be received under the form of the Body of Christ only and in the hand, those who are unwell or at high risk due to compromised immune or respiratory system must not attend; those over 70 should exercise particular caution.

## Family Discussion—for Trinity Sunday

Trinity is a word that means 'made up of three', and today we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity that honours our understanding of three persons in one God.

Who are the three persons that make up the Trinity?

Whenever we make the Sign of the Cross, we are remembering that we believe in the Holy Trinity: one God who is three Persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

At their Baptism, Christians are baptised in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Have a look at photos or videos from family baptisms.

Make the sign of the cross on each other's forehead to remember your Baptism.


