







In a nutshell

The people have seen many miracles, and wonder 'Who is this man?'

Jesus asks his disciples the same question. Peter replies, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.'

Responding to this God-given revelation, Jesus recognises Peter's faith as the rock on which the Church will be built.

God's grace will sustain him to the end, despite his own frailty.

Today's Readings

Isaiah 22:19-23 Romans 11:33-36 Matthew 16:13-20 I place the key of the House of David upon his shoulder From him, through him, and in him are all things You are Peter, to you I will give the keys of the kingdom of heaven

fter Peter confesses that Jesus is "the Christ, the Son of the living God," Jesus makes his own profession about Peter, "You are Peter/ and upon this rock I will build my church." As Catholics, we treasure this verse as the biblical foundation of the ministry of the pope who leads from the chair of St. Peter. Within our church, the role of the pope is a unifying force that draws us into communion with each other.

Despite Jesus' elevation of Peter, he is not a perfect disciple. In only a few more verses, after he protests Jesus' prediction of this passion and earth, Jesus will issue a startling rebuke: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me." Never in the gospels has Jesus' proverb that the exalted shall be humbled (Matt23:12) taken effect so quickly! Despite denying Jesus three times during his passion, Peter is forgiven and restored by the risen Lord and continues to lead the early church until his martyrdom in Rome. In many ways the story of Peter should bring us hope. We also are not perfect disciples. We, too, will stumble and fall at times, and yet if we remain faithful, Jesus can use our lives to build up and strengthen his church.

Our history as a church is made up of saints and sinners. At certain times in history the people of God have suffered greatly under the leadership of corrupt ministers. In today's gospel Jesus make a promise we can cling to even today, saying of the church, "The gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it." Because the church is made up of humans, its is sinful and always in need of purification and renewals. Because it is the spouse of Christ, it is beloved and redeemed, and shall not be overcome by evil.


This Sunday: We welcome our children for Children's Liturgy at 9.30am Family Mass.




