

In a nutshell

The scene of the Last Judgement can seem a very formidable occasion. God calls to himself those who have been concerned about the welfare of others, when they were thirsty, hungry, sick, or a stranger or in prison.

To be loving towards others, and generous with our time, is an expression of our love for God. At the end of time we will be judged on love.



Today we celebrate Christ the King Sunday, our final Sunday of the church year and, fittingly, our gospel speaks to us of what will happen at the end of time "when the Son of Man comes in this glory." He will sit in judgment of the nations, and if we were wondering how we will be judged, Jesus spells it out. Those who enter in the kingdom of heaven will be the ones who fed the hungry, gave water to the thirsty, welcomed the stranger, clothed the naked, cared for the ill, and visited the imprisoned. These are the nonnegotiable actions of discipleship. When we show love and care for others, we are living and caring for Christ, and when we insulate ourselves from suffering and turn away, we are rejecting Christ.

Let's take some time this Sunday to consider, if someone were to look objectively at the actions that have made up our lives, would we be indentified as a sheep or goat (as in the Gospel story)?
