In a nutshell

The parable of the wise and foolish virgins shows that to enter the kingdom of heaven, we must each do our part.

No one can make our response for us. Each of us must be found watching and waiting for his coming.

We must have our lamps filled and alight, meaning that our lives must show our persevering efforts to be faithful to what God asks.

Wisdom 6:12-16 God's wisdom is not distant, but reveals herself to those who are alert to her presence. 1Thessalonians 4:13-18 Paul offers a word of consolation and hope Matthew 25:1-13 The wise are those who prepare for the day of the Lord's coming



Today's parable of the ten virgins gives us an opportunity to ponder the second coming of Christ and the time when we will meet the Lord of life at the end of our own lives. Its imagery also might remind us of how we began our lives as Christians with new life through the baptismal waters and by receiving the light of the Christ from the paschal candle.

If we were baptized as infants, our parents and godparents were told, "This light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly. This child of yours has been enlightened by Christ. He is to walk always as a child of light. May he keep the flame of faith alive in his heart. When the Lord comes, may he go out to meet him with all the saints in the heavenly kingdom" (Rite of Baptism for Children 100).

As we grow, this responsibility to keep the flame of faith alive is transferred more and more to each of us. We are always to remember that we are children of the light and to nourish the flame received at baptism it will be burning brightly until the last breath we take.

In today's parable, the foolish virgins have not brought enough oil to keep their lamps lit, and when the bridegroom finally arrives they are not waiting joyfully to greet him. As we contemplate this parable we might wonder, what is this oil that keeps the light of Christ alive within us? We might also ponder, is this oil something that another can give to us, or is it something that we must find on our own? We have received the light of Christ in baptism; now our task is to keep it burning brightly until we meet the Lord.


