Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord 2nd / 3rd January 2021

In a nutshell

Jesus was born in Judea. Today, all the nations seek to welcome and adore him, the light of the world.

The wise men find a baby in very humble circumstances, yet they know that this child is the one for whom they are searching.

The star will guide us too, if we are attentive to the gentle whisper of God's voice urging us to walk in his ways.

Isaiah 60:1-6Light has come; the glory of the Lord shines upon youEphesians 3:2-3,5-6Spirit's revelation, that we are all parts of the same body of ChristMatthew 2:1-12We have come from the East to worship the King



The feast of the Epiphany celebrates the revelation of Jesus to humankind. The wise men are the representatives of humanity bearing witness to this revelation. However, the Epiphany celebrates the revelation of Jesus as not only the Messiah of Israel, but the Saviour of the whole world.

Interestingly, in this gospel that emphasizes the 'Jewish-ness' of Jesus, the witnesses to the birth are gentiles from a foreign land. Their inclusion is a powerful declaration that the revelation of Jesus is for all people. Regardless of the liturgical year, this reading is always used on the feast of the Epiphany to celebrate this pivotal moment.

The wise men, or Magi, are warned in a dream not to go back to Herod and they go home by a different way. How could they do anything but go home another way — indeed, go home as different people? They are changed by their encounter with the child Jesus and they go home a different way; in a different state; in a whole different frame of mind.

When we genuinely encounter Jesus – in scripture, in life, in prayer, in ourselves – then we cannot go home the same way; we must go home by a different way as the Magi did.
