# Reflection on readings for First Sunday in Lent.

All three readings today remind us of the desire of God leading us to "aspire not to have more, but to be more." The rainbow in the sky, the covenant, the baptism of Jesus and his temptation in the wilderness all remind us of the salvation that God wants for us and for our world. In the gospel, Jesus proclaims. "This is the time of fulfilment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

As John baptises Jesus, his true identity as the Son of God is revealed. "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased". Immediately following this we are told that Jesus was driven into the wilderness for forty days. We have all experienced being in a wilderness in our lives. Sometimes there is more than one experience of wilderness in our lives, where we are lost, confused and searching. *Caritas Australia, 2021*
