## **Something to Think About**

Imagine you are sitting on the top of a mountain. What can you see? What do you hear? What can you smell? How do you feel?

#### The Story

In today's gospel, Jesus takes his closest friends with him and goes up a mountain where they can be alone and pray. Jesus is transformed right before their eyes, and his clothes become shining white. Moses and Elijah, who lived long before Jesus, appear from heaven beside Jesus. A cloud passes over everyone on the mountain, and the voice of God comes from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, and I love him. Listen to what he says."
