





Mark 14:1-15:47 Mark tells the story of the passion and death of Jesus Christ.

# "My God, my God, why have you deserted me"

We can read the passion stories as foundation stories of our belief. Jesus suffered, died and rose again that we might be served and join with him. In his glory. But what difference do the stories make to the way we understand life and the way we live? Like Mark's first audience we too have to deal with the way things go wrong in our lives, not necessarily through any fault of our own. What we learn from the passion stories is that our lives, too, are part of this great mystery of redemption. How we live, the choices we make, can become part of that great act of love.

This is more difficult to grasp in relation to our own suffering. It is easier to grasp when we consider how we can use our lives to relieve the sufferings of others. We have thought about those whose lives are so often undervalued by our work. What can we do to turn such attitudes around? We may think we are able to do very little, but that little is as precious as the drop in the ocean that, together with all the other drops, helps to change the world. It is also through our pursuit of the healing and nurturing of others that we come to a better understand of our own suffering, seeing it as an act of giving on our part towards the wider mystery of redemption.


