He says to them words which we all wish to hear: 'Peace be with you'. He breathes the Spirit on them.


A week later, Thomas also is convinced and says, with us, 'My Lord and my God'!

Inspiration from Pope Francis

How many of us are searching deep in our hearts to meet Jesus, just as he is: kind, merciful, tender! For we know, deep down, that he's like this. Having rediscovered personal contact with Christ who is amiable and mercifully patient, Thomas understood the profound significance of his Resurrection and, intimately transformed, he declared his full and total faith in him exclaiming: 'My Lord and my God!' All of us too are like Thomas; on this second Sunday of Easter we are called to contemplate, the wounds of the Risen One, Divine Mercy, which overcomes all human limitations, and shines on the darkness of evil and sin. 


This position is Tuesday and Wednesday 9am –3pm, also flexibility is required during sacramental period, special Masses over the weekends and RCIA program.
