### OUR SPIRITUALITY OF THE HEART

The presence of God at the heart of the universe makes the world sacred and this presence draws us to transcend our own being through love, a love that has as its source the Heart of God.

We are called to be God's Heart on Earth and to offer ourselves to be used as source of healing for the wounds of our world. Please remember to sign in with the QR code when entering the church, or sign in if you can't do it on your phone—no need to do both.


