In a nutshell

The apostles re-joined Jesus after their mission of preaching and healing.

He invited them to go with him to a lonely place, where they could be by themselves, rest and replenish their spiritual and physical energy.

But the people were clamouring to hear Jesus and he chose to respond to their needs.

The apostles, too, must have been replenished by listening to his teaching, despite the crowd.

Today's Readings

Jeremiah 23:1-6 The remnant of my flock I will gather to me, and bring them back to their pastures.

Ephesians 2:13-18 Christ, our peace, has made us one.

Mark 6:30-34 They were as sheep without as shepherd.



The readings for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time for Year B are focused on Jesus Christ, as the one who loves and cares for us as a shepherd, and also the need to care for ourselves. In the first reading God warns against those who lead his people astray and scatter his flock. And in the gospel Jesus and his disciples leave to get some rest, but when followed by the crowd, he is moved by how lost the crowd is, and how much they need a shepherd.

Discussion for these readings might focus on the need for rest, especially Sabbath rest, the emotions of Jesus, or how God always cares for us.

Gospel – <u>Mark 6:30-34</u>: "When he disembarked and saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, for they were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things." (Young Catholics website)

Raise your voices

Entrance antiphon: See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with

willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good.

Response to the psalm: The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.

Gospel acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! My sheep listen to my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.


