This is the first commandment, and the second is similar to it.

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time 31st October 2021

In a nutshell

Today we celebrate our future: eternal life praising and glorifying God. We are journeying through time with our eyes fixed on the world to come where we will see God face to face.

Today's gospel passage of the Beatitudes calls 'happy' those on earth who are gentle, merciful, poor in spirit, peacemakers and those who suffer for what is right.

May we all find a place in God's heavenly kingdom.

Jesus' response to the question about which is the first commandment of all directs us to the heart of the identity of the people of God. For people of the Jewish faith, the most succinct way of expressing their identity was - and is to this day - by reciting the Shema Yisrael, quoted in both today's first reading and Gospel: "Listen, Israel: the Lord our God is the one Lord." It's something to be recited daily and so important that often these are the last words a dying Jewish person utters. Jesus links this core belief with his second commandment: love of neighbor as oneself.

Mark's Gospel tells us that the answer is simply to make love the centre of who we are: to live by love and not to give in to fear and despair, which are the opposite of love. St John tells us that perfect love casts out fear. Love of God and love of neighbour as oneself is how we remain true to our deepest self in the here and now, with all its pressures and challenges; and it is how we can confidently prepare for the day when we will face the Son of God. It is love which most clearly identifies who we are, where we have come from, how we are to live now and what our future is to be. This is an identity which can never be stolen from us.


