First Sunday of Advent 28th November 2021

In a nutshell

Today we begin the season of Advent, a time when we are asked to 'stay awake' and be alert.

We are asked to act with integrity, and to turn away from anything that will dull our perception of the coming of Christ.

It is a time of finetuning our priorities. We are clay in the hands of the potter, God, who yearns for our love and attentiveness.

Today's Readings

Jeremiah 33:14-16; I will cause a good seed to spring forth from David.

Thessalonians 3:12-4:2; When Christ comes may he strengthen your hearts in holiness.

Luke 21:25-28.34-36 Your redemption is near at hand.



The readings for the first Sunday in Advent, Year C warn us to get ready for the coming of our Lord, for change will come with him. In the first reading we hear that God will raise up "a just shoot" who will bring safety. In the second reading Paul encourages us to act with love and be ready for the coming of Jesus Christ. In the gospel, Jesus warns his followers not to focus on our current lives but to be ready for our new lives.

Here at St Brigid's, the advent wreath has been assembled; the first violet candle is lit indicating that our time of preparing for the King is at hand. Everyone has a hint of excitement as Christmas holidays approach. We are very busy with the end of the school year. However, it's easy with in all this activity, especially with Christmas music playing and Christmas decorations everywhere we go, to forget about the quiet preparation of Advent.

So, we know that Christ, who is perfect love, does not want us to fear, but wants us to rejoice with awareness. He wants us not to get lost in the celebration, but to celebrate, that we have been found in him. Find quiet and peaceful moments, to speak with God and be reminded that the time of celebration is at hand, and not yet at hand. Christ, Love and Fulfillment, is here now and still has not yet come again. We are both in a state of rejoicing and preparation. I encourage us this Advent season, amidst the jingles and the bright shining lights, to find quiet solitude where we can allow the anticipatory excitement to grow and we can prepare ourselves to celebrate the coming of our King of Kings, Jesus Christ!
