# The Joy of Forgiveness



The story of the prodigal son confirms Jesus' words that there is great rejoicing in heaven over one repentant sinner. The joyful and lavish banquet prepared by the Father to celebrate his son's return is a symbol of the heavenly banquet.

In this story the older son cuts himself off from the banquet. Unable to forgive like his father, he chooses to stay outside in his own private hell. May we know and experience the joy of forgiveness and the joy of forgiving.

Entrance antiphon: Rejoice, Jerusalem! Be glad for her, you who love her; rejoice with her, you who mourned for her, and you will find contentment at her consoling breasts.

Response to the psalm: Taste and see the goodness of the Lord.

Gospel acclamation: Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus Christ!

I will rise and go to my father and tell him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

### Today's Gospel in a nutshell

There are many people today who seem to give no heed to God. Their lives are full of ephemeral things.

The younger son in today's parable is a prime example. Yet, after he has tasted the riches, and then the dregs, of society, he comes to his senses. He returns to his father, who welcomes him home joyfully. It is never too late to come back to God.
