

Spirituality of the Heart

Feast of the Sacred Heart (Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time) 25th June/ 26th June

Prayer to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**

O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you, I love you, and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine.

Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to your will. Grant, Good Jesus, that I may live in you and for you.

Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death.

For the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart, the heart of Jesus reveals a God who is love and who loves creation intimately and unreservedly. The presence of God at the heart of the universe makes the world sacred and this presence draws us to transcend our own being through love, a love that has as its source the Heart of God.

Spirituality of the Heart reverences the human heart as loved by God unconditionally, and as the privileged place of encounter with God. Living such spirituality involves making the journey into one's own heart and into the heart of the human condition, open to encountering there the compassionate heart of Jesus.

Spirituality of the Heart is a missionary spirituality. It calls us to be everywhere, in every culture and at every level of society. Religious, diocesan priests and laity all share this mission; the laity have a unique role to play in this mission and are indispensable to it.


