Readings for this weekend

Jeremiah 38:4-6,8-10 You bore me to a be a man of strife for the whole world. Hebrews 12:1-4 Let us bear patiently the struggle placed upon us Luke 12:49-53 I have come to bring fire to the earth.

Discipleship is a test of endurance, concentration and conviction.

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, 14 August 2022.

Jesus is journeying to Jerusalem. He tells his disciples that he must receive another baptism

his passion and death.

In a nutshell

This prospect fills him with dread. His teaching and the scandal of the cross will divide his fellow Jews, the religious authorities, families, even his own relatives.

But through it all 'let us not lose sight of Jesus, who leads us in our faith and brings it to perfection.'

No single metaphor sums up the demands of discipleship, but a fruitful one implied in today's text from Hebrews is that of the marathon. It's a test of endurance, concentration and conviction, all the qualities Jesus exhibited on his way from Nazareth to Golgotha and glory.

We might imagine him as our pace-maker, always ahead, always calling for more from us. Only by discarding 'everything that hinders us' can we keep close to him. Only by keeping him in sight can our hope of completing the race be realized.

We draw inspiration from the countless others – that great cloud of witnesses – who have completed the race before us. Their one counsel for us might well be, never take your eyes off Jesus.
