#### In a nutshell

A passing acquaintance with Jesus, even eating and drinking with him, will not assure our entrance into God's kingdom.

Yet, God loves every person and wants to gather people of every race and language into the kingdom.

It is in loving relationship with God, loving one another and accepting suffering as part of our training, that we will be gathered into eternal life with him.

## GOSPEL REFLECTION

I enter very gently into this time of prayer. As I read the text a few times, what am I noticing? What is drawing me? Am I struggling with anything? I pause to ponder why. Like the earlier reading, the theme here is of universality. Jesus is revealing a kingdom where status and assumptions are turned on their heads. The Father's reign is one that is freely open to all, but not one that can be earned or claimed by any.

I ponder the priorities of the Lord. Who are the ones invited by God? Who does God open the door to, to gather in? Do I feel part of this group? I pause to talk with the Lord about this.

Then, am I open and invitational in response? As I look over my week, have there been occasions when I have felt excluded ... or excluded someone? What are (or who are) my priorities?

I remain with the Lord, getting to know him more deeply, hearing him say in return, 'I do know you'. I end with a slow sign of the cross.


