

# **Focusing the Gospel**

**Key words and phrases:** "the person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones: and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones."

To the point: Character counts. We hear this a lot growing up, but what it really means is what Jesus is talking about here. When we are asked to do things we should not weigh them on a scale of what benefits us and what we can "get away with," but what is correct, as if all of our dealings were made public. In fact, they are public, in the eyes of the Lord.

Jesus tells us that we cannot serve both God and the world. What good is it if we make a show of devotion and prayer, while designing a life of ensured financial comfort? Where is the line between appropriate care for one's well-being and family, and exaggerated need based on secular expectations? Or the line between respect from one's neighbours and awe because of boasted accomplishment? These are age-old questions, and the struggle to serve our true Master, and no one else, is a struggle in which we all participate.
