Gospel Reflection

As I come to my time and place of prayer, I look back over the past few days. Where have I noticed the presence of God in my life? Have there been times when I have felt distant from God? I bring all these movements and moments of my life before the Lord, trusting in his transforming power.

Having settled my body and mind to pray, I read through the letter to Timothy slowly, several times. Perhaps I imagine that it has been written to me by a dear friend in the Lord, who wants to support me in my faith life.

If there is a particular part of the letter that touches my heart, I make this the focus of my prayer. I re-read those words prayerfully and ask God for whatever help I may need. Or maybe I imagine seeing myself filled with the gifts of the Spirit listed here: with faith ... with love ... with patience ... with gentleness.

If I visualise myself in this way, what do I notice about how I feel and respond to the needs of the world? Where does the Lord want me to use the gifts he has given me? I ask God, the source of all life, to fill me with awareness of his gifts, and for the grace I need to centre my life on them. I draw my prayer to an end with a slow sign of the cross, offering my own words of thanks to the Lord.

Entrance antiphon: O Lord, you had just cause to judge us as you did: because we sinned against you and disobeyed your will. But now show us your greatness of heart, and treat us with your unbounded kindness.

Response to the psalm: Praise the Lord, my soul!

Gospel acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus Christ was rich but he became poor, to make you rich out of his poverty. Alleluia!
