Gospel Reflection

Luke 18:1-8

What is my favourite prayer position? Kneeling, standing, sitting, lying face down ...? Does it vary according to where I am? And what of my hands? Are they joined, on my lap, or perhaps raised up high, like Moses in today's reading?

I spend some time reflecting on this, and after a while adopt the position that seems most appropriate to me today. Slowly, paying attention to the words, I read the text and try to visualize the scene. What strikes me? Maybe it is that Moses is not alone? I ponder the role of his friends.

Thinking of my own life, how often do I pray on my own? Is this my preferred way of connecting with the Lord? I reflect on what comes to my mind. Aaron and Hur support Moses when he becomes tired. Who helps me to pray when I am weary and things don't go as I hope? I speak to the Lord about this. Or maybe at the moment I feel isolated and without support? If so, I ask God for the help I need, trusting that he is always there for me.

I spend a few moments looking around me. Is there someone I know who relies on me to help them pray? Could I do even more by perhaps enlisting someone else to support them as they pray? When I am ready, I close my prayer with my own words of thanks.


