Gospel Reflection

As I begin to settle gently for my prayer, I make sure I am comfortable, taking as long as I need to become still. I intentionally place myself in the Lord's presence. I know he is here with me, and spend a few minutes quietly savouring this special time. Perhaps I sense his warm, tender gaze resting upon me, just like the warmth of the sun's rays.

When ready, I slowly read and reread the Psalm, joining in this joyful song of praise. I pause after each verse, allowing the words to soak in. What am I noticing? How am I feeling? Perhaps there is a word or phrase that resonates for me? Or maybe an image forms? I ponder this, and speak with the Lord about whatever arises.

I may like to imagine the instruments and the singing as the people's acclaim the Lord as King. Or perhaps I hear the clamour of all creation giving joyful praise to the Lord: the seas, rivers, and hills; the world and all peoples. Am I able to take part in this song of praise?

If there is something holding me back, I speak openly to the Lord from my heart, just as I would a close friend. I listen to whatever he might be saying to me, too. Giving thanks for this time, I gently bring my prayer to a close. *Glory be ...*
