### **IN A NUTSHELL**

It appears from the passage that Mary's child is to be called both Jesus and "Emmanuel". Emmanuel is not intended as a different name for Jesus but rather one of the many titles that will be applied to him.

The title means "God-is-with-us". That one word, Emmanuel, sums up the essence of Jewish and Christian belief.

The Jewish people's faith in God was built on the basis that God travelled with them and through their lives. Christians believe that God took on an even closer sense of being with us through God's incarnation in the life of Jesus.
