# Gospel Reflection

In recent years, scientists have described how trees communicate with each other through roots and fungus. God's marvelous design reveals that the health of one tree relies on the surrounding trees.

This is a metaphor for how interconnected we are and reminds us that each of us comes from a family and complex system of culture and relationships. If one bears bad fruit or no fruit at all, the whole community is affected. John vehemently calls us to repent in order to bear good fruit or else we, like the tree and chaff, will be separated.

**Entrance antiphon:** People of Zion, the Lord will come to save all nations, and your hearts will exult to hear his majestic voice.

**Response to the psalm:** Justice shall flourish in his time, and fullness of peace forever.

**Gospel acclamation:** Alleluia, alleluia! Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths: all people shall see the salvation of God. Alleluia!

#### **Jewellery for victims of Domestic Violence**


WOOLLOOMOOLOO, seems to be a gathering place for people on the margins of society-homeless people, couch dwellers, car dwellers and victims of domestic violence. There are many services offered for these people but one group that we support is the victims of domestic violence. We do this by supporting a lady who lives among the marginalized at Woolloomooloo. Amongst other things, she runs classes for women who have been abused. At the moment they are doing art classes, patchwork guilt classes and jewellery classes.


