IN A NUTSHELL

Rejoice! Have courage, hope, and do not be afraid. In prison, John the Baptist hears of the wonders Jesus is doing.

We too can be joyful messengers to the world, as we live out our lives in truth and integrity.

By our ordinary, everyday kindness we preach the Gospel in our words and actions.

Readings for this weekend

Isaiah 35:1-6,10 God himself will come and save us.

James 5:7-10 You also must be patient; do not lose heart, the Lord's coming will be soon.

Matthew 11:2-11 Are you the one who is to come, or must we wait for someone else?

Reading

Be patient, brothers and sisters, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient with it until it receives the early and the late rains. You too must be patient. Make your hearts firm because the coming of the Lord is at hand . Do not complain, brothers and sisters, about one another, that you may not be judged. Behold the Judge is standing before the gates. Take as an example of hardship and patience, brothers an sisters, the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

Reflection

If you are a gardner this reading provides rich wisdom. Like the hope of a farmer who is waiting for the soaking rain, sun pollinators, rich soil, growth and ripening, we wait in hope this Advent season for the fulfillment of the promises of God. We wait with hopeful and expected patience for the time when God returns. Are there seeds or projects you've planted and lost hope in? Perhaps there are things God has sown in you you've been too impatient to nurture? Allow God to take his time in you and in the needs of the world around you.
