In a Nutshell

We are not sheep, but we can make a choice to follow Jesus and be part of his flock. Jesus promises us his life and love, to be shared with others.

We are not asked to be mindless imitators of another person or to be swayed by specious arguments.

Jesus is the gate through which we enter into the fullness of life he came to bring us.

Readings for this weekend

Acts 2:14,36-41 1Peter 2:20-25 John 10:1-10 In a loud voice Peter proclaims that the one who was crucified is the Christ Christ Jesus leaves an example. Through his wounds we are healed Jesus uses the images of shepherd sheepfold to show his love for us

Gospel Teaching

All four Gospel writers use the metaphor of Jesus as shepherd. John explains that the life and work of Jesus demonstrate God's love for everyone. Just as the sheep recognise the shepherd's voice, so we know the voice of Jesus when he calls us. This kind of love resembles the love the Father has for Jesus. It is a love that binds us at once to the Father, to Jesus and to each other. The gate guards against all that threatens the well-being of the sheep. Jesus emphasises that sheep recognise the voice of the one who cares for them. They follow their shepherd and will not follow a stranger whose voice they do not know.

"Life" or "eternal life" in John's Gospel is not just about life after death. It is life that begins here and now; it is knowing the one true God and Jesus Christ whom God has sent. It is knowing the voice of the good shepherd who truly cares for us. It is life in community, finding security and nourishment as part of the flock. It is life that abounds in meaning and value, and endures even beyond death. For John, Jesus reveals the presence of God. The thief comes to kill and destroy, but Jesus comes to offer life in abundance.
