## Readings for this weekend

Acts 2:1-11 They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak different language 1 Corinthians 12:3-7,12-13 In the one Spirit we were all baptized, making one body.

John 20:19-23 As the Father sent me, so I send you: Receive the Holy Spirit

#### REFLECTION

I prepare myself for this time of prayer in the way that suits me best today. Remembering that I am in the presence of the Lord, I begin my prayer using the words of the Gospel Acclamation: 'Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.'

After reading the Gospel slowly a few times, I use my imagination to enter into the scene of the first Pentecost. What do I notice about the room where the disciples are gathered? What would it have felt like to have been gathered there in fear and confusion? Have there been times when I have felt something similar?

Recalling such a time, I imagine the risen Lord standing alongside me, bringing his peace and breathing the Holy Spirit upon me. How do I feel now? What is Jesus sending me to do? I speak to the Lord as I would to a dear friend about my time of prayer. Imagining that I remain within the peaceful presence of Jesus, together we pray as one: *Our Father . . .*

Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking in the sky The Lord will return, just as you have seen him ascend, alleluia.

**Response to the psalm**: God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord. or Alleluia.

**Gospel acclamation:** Alleluia, alleluia! Go and teach all people my gospel. I am with you always, until the end of the world. Alleluia

## St Brigid's This Week and Beyond


#### Dear Parishioners,
