

In a nutshell

In trust and simplicity we hear the Word of God.If we think we know it all, the Word passes over us and we don't hear it.

In the depths of our hearts, we are all equal. If we nestle in the heart of Jesus, we will come to know him and the Father too.

Our souls will find refreshment and know the gentleness of the heart of God.

Matthew 11:25-30 I am gentle and humble of heart.

"Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened."

See how humbly your king comes to you!

Shouldering Christ's easy yoke, and learning from him, is what he tells us to do. And we can do this in all sorts of ways. First of all by experiencing his gentleness and humility, so that we can love him and realize his love for us. He does not want life to be a burden.

He may suggest we let go in some ways, changing our priorities; maybe like Jesus who, when he was burdened with the heavy cross, did not insist on carrying it alone but was glad to have someone to help him: Simon of Cyrene. Sometimes it may just mean talking to someone. "Trouble shared is trouble halved": is a proverb attributed to Dorothy Sayers.

Jesus answers our prayers when we ask his help, and he gives us the strength to carry on, with a peace that comes from the Spirit of Christ living in us.
