REFLECTION

Today I come to spend some 'quality time' with the Lord. Perhaps I need to clear my mind of any problems and concerns first. I may have my own way of doing that, or I may simply take a couple of deep breaths, and perhaps repeat a favourite phrase like 'Come, Lord Jesus. come!'

Only then do I read St Paul's words, slowly and prayerfully. They may be familiar, but I try to ponder their meaning as if for the first time. What are these words telling me? How do they apply to my own life? Paul seems to have achieved a measure of contentment and serenity in all circumstances with the help of the One who gives him strength. I ponder this. How do I feel before Paul's equanimity? Perhaps envious, sceptical, galvanised to try to do the same, or . . .?

I turn to the Lord, and, in my own words, tell him what is in my heart, trusting that he knows and understands me fully. Perhaps I also focus on the gratitude Paul feels towards the Philippians and the absolute faith in God this shows. There may have been times in my life where I could have been more grateful after someone helped me. What held me back? I stay with this as long as I need. There is no need to rush.

Trusting in the Lord's presence with me, I speak with him as I would to a dear friend. Eventually I say goodbye, hopefully able to thank God for the insights and the strength he has given me today.

Response to the psalm: I shall live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life.
