Reflection...

From the beginning of this Mass, we agreed that if we're looking for someone to guide us through the final days of Advent, into our Christmas celebrations, and finally into the living-out of the Christmas message in the year ahead, we could not do better than turn to our Blessed Lady.

If we take time, make time – even just a few minutes each day in this often hectic period – to recall how Mary treasured and pondered "these things" in her heart, we too will ponder them, and come to appreciate why the wonder of Christ's birth – even at the end of a difficult year like 2023 – calls for celebration, for rejoicing and for gentle, loving wonder, in the company of Mary. It is she who best teaches us how to love Jesus; it is she who shows us, despite our littleness, to love Jesus as she did by making him the love of our lives. And so as Pope St John Paul II put it, "the faithful, living in the spirit of the liturgy, by thinking about the inexpressible love with which the Virgin Mother awaited her son, are invited to take her as model and prepare themselves to meet the Saviour".

Every Sunday two collections are taken up with the first collection supporting all the clergy and the second collection supporting the parish.

At all Christmas masses we will only do one collection and this will be donated to Children in Need.
