#### REFLECTION

I settle myself, comfortable but alert, in the place I have chosen to pray, and become still in whatever way works best for me today. With open hands and an open heart, I invite the Lord to come and sit beside me as I slowly read the words of the psalm a number of times, perhaps aloud if I can. I notice where my attention is drawn, and listen for what the Lord wants to teach me.

Perhaps there is a particular area of my life where there is uncertainty. Am I struggling to find the right path? Or maybe there is a path that, for some reason, I am reluctant to follow? Might that reluctance be my unwillingness to trust . . . or fear of failure . . . or fear of success, even? Or is it something else? I share my feelings openly with the Lord, as I would with a treasured friend.

Returning to the text, my thoughts may turn to those times when I know I've strayed from the right path. I recall how that was. Perhaps I can envisage how it feels to acknowledge my failings and know the loving mercy and forgiveness of God.

If this is difficult, I might want to ponder God's love for me – love given freely, not because I have earned or deserve it – but simply because of God's goodness. When ready, I end my prayer with words of thanksgiving. Glory be . . .

Entrance antiphon: Sing a new song to the Lord! Sing to the Lord, all the earth.

Truth and beauty surround him; he lives in holiness and glory.

Response to the Psalm: Teach me your ways, O Lord.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! The kingdom of God is near: believe the Good News! Alleluia!
