In a nutshell

A leper appeals to Jesus' compassion:

'If you want to...' Indeed, Jesus *does* want to cure him, and not only him, but everyone who asks.

In his joy, the man could not keep the cure to himself, but proclaimed the good news everywhere.

We too can proclaim the Kingdom of God by our joy and enthusiasm in being followers of Christ, because we also have been healed many times.

Readings for this weekend

Leviticus 13:1-2.44-4 1 Corinthians 10:31-11:1 Mark 1:40-45 As long as he is unclean, he must live alone, outside the camp. Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.

The leprosy left him and he was cured.

Reflection

People afflicted with leprosy and similar skin diseases were regarded as untouchables in the Jewish society of Jesus' day. In keeping with the Law, they had to proclaim their uncleanness publicly and keep their distance from all but their own kind.

Today's Gospel story, narrated with an economy of detail, poignantly captures the pariah status of one such unfortunate man. No onlookers are identified; there are only two characters - the leper in need of compassion and Jesus mericfully responsive to his need. In a sense, Jesus take upon himself the uncleanness of the leper; for in touching him he renders himself, according to the Law, ritually impure.

In our own day there are classes of people who are bracketed out by society - outcasts judged harshly as inferior beings by law-abiding citizens and condemned to lead lives of conspicuous miser. Even as we stand by them in faith and love, we can make our own. the leper's prayer: "Lord, if you want to, you can cure me."

Entrance antiphon: Lord, be my rock of safety, the stronghold that saves me. For the honour of your name, lead me and quide me.

Response to the psalm: I turn to you, Lord, in time of trouble, and you fill me with the joy of salvation.

Gospel acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! A great prophet has appeared among us; God has visited his people. Alleluia!


